Please briefly present your organization (e.g., its type, scope of work, areas of activity, approximate number of paid and unpaid staff and members of the group)	<p>The social cooperative Il Faro has been active in the territory of Brindisi, Mesagne and Latiano since 2014. It manages a residential community for pregnant women and mothers with children who have come from situations of serious disadvantage (violence, asylum request, housing shortages and family network, etc.).</p> <p>It manages reception of MSNA asylum seekers in emergency situations. Since its inception, being made up of professionals who have worked for years in the reception of women with children, Il Faro has set a goal to innovate the concept of community by designing an active place where the reception logic is reversed. No longer is it that the residential community promotes the cultural events, but it is the cultural events, laboratories, shows and agricultural areas</p>

	<p>who welcome those in the residential community and support what is not covered by public funding.</p> <p>To this end, Il Faro has purchased a property located in Brindisi, surrounded by four hectares of land, bordered on two sides by the Giancola canal (whose mouth is an SIC area - Site of Community Interest) near the Torre Guaceto nature reserve. The building consists of two large apartments and 800 square metres of laboratories for experimental theatre laboratories and spaces for art, crafts and cultural activities as well as for laboratories for environmental awareness.</p> <p>The project idea is to see that the reception of women takes place in an active place that is rich in cultural stimuli, educational opportunities and opportunities for personal growth.</p> <p>Il Faro has been promoting training activities for its staff since 2015, strongly believing in the continuous training of the team members and coordinated actions of the territorial network.</p> <p>Specifically, the Il Faro project involved all the associations / cooperatives / foundations included in this consortium during the design phases.</p>
